From I-75/85 (Downtown Connector):
Exit 248C – MLK Jr. Dr. / State Capitol

From I-20:
Exit 58A – Capitol Ave

Parking Options:

- Pete Hackey Parking Deck
162 Jessie Hill Jr. Dr. SE
\$10 *all day* — Best option for price. Connected by a covered walkway to the Floyd Building, directly across from the Capitol.
- Steve Polk Plaza
65 Martin Luther King Jr. Dr. SW
\$15–\$20 *all day* — Near Underground Atlanta and Central Presbyterian Church.

- Capitol Lot Daily
218 Capitol Avenue
\$15–\$20 *all day* — Directly across from the Capitol. Limited space and fills up quickly.

Entering the Capitol & Legislative Office Buildings

Georgia State Capitol:

Enter through the ground-floor doors on Mitchell Street / Capitol Square SW.

Coverdell Legislative Office Building (CLOB):

Located directly across Mitchell Street from the Capitol.
